14th November



Karmic Relationships, Volume 1

These profoundly esoteric lectures examine the laws inherent in reincarnation and karma and explore in detail the incarnations of specific historical figures. The opportunity to study this lecture series in a group affords us a chance to really get to grips with these fundamental issues, which demonstrate the realities of the workings of karma in human life. This first volume is an essential basis for such a study.

The Temple Legend

We will be continuing with the lectures given to members of Rudolf Steiner's first Esoteric School between 1904 and 1906. They throw light on the content of the picture-language of myths, sagas and legends. Pictures, Steiner explains, are the real origin of all things – the primeval spiritual causes. In order to

work with pictures or symbols today we first need to become acquainted with their esoteric content.

Steiner gave these lectures as a necessary preparation for the planned second section of his Esoteric School, which was to deal in a direct way with a renewal of ritual and symbolism. They clarify the history and nature of the cultic tradition including principally Freemasonry and its background, but also the Rosicrucians, Manichaeism, the Druids, the Prometheus Saga, the Lost Temple, Cain and Abel – and much else besides.

Continuing with these Stuttgart lectures which are an extremely accessible introduction to the ideas and content of spiritual science and form an excellent and concise complement to Steiner's basic written works, *Theosophy* and *Cosmic Memory*. They cover the nature of the human being, the three worlds, life after death, karma, the evolutionary epochs, and the path of inner development.

The path of human evolution to absurdity may be countered only by travelling the path that leads to the spirit: the Michael path, which becomes the path of Christ. Perhaps it's time we paid attention.

The Rosicrucian Path of Transformation

With Bastiaan Baan

4th October

The Rosicrucian path is one of inner transformation of the soul, outlined in the allegorical story told in one of the most important writings of esoteric Christianity: The Chymical Wedding of Christian Rosenkreutz. This work, first published anonymously in German in 1616, draws on concepts from Christianity and alchemy. By following the path of one who follows a call, meets many challenges and finally arrives at the Wedding, we are offered the opportunity of undergoing personal transformation by meditating on the significance of the events that are portrayed. Bastiaan Baan's interpretation of this work combined with the insights Rudolf Steiner brings makes it very accessible and relevant to our lives

Bastiaan Baan worked as a teacher in the Netherlands before being ordained in 1981. He was a Christian Community priest in the Netherlands and director of the priests' seminary in Spring Valley, NY. He lectures widely and is an accomplished author and published a commentary on the Chymical Wedding of Christian Rosenkreutz in 2016.

Tolerance is not enough. The Transformation of Architecture into the Social Art With Andrew Wolpert

11th October

In a world of antagonism, prejudice and intolerance, we could easily imagine tolerance as an ideal to be striven for. And yet it is not enough. The continued development of the human being and

the metamorphosis of the arts are essential aspects of the imagination Rudolf Steiner offers us for our future. That the spatial quality of sculpture could evolve into the dimension of time and become eurythmy is already a well-practised artistic reality. The metamorphosis of architecture into the social art is something we have to work to achieve in the future, and is inseparably connected with what lies beyond tolerance. Architecture lends itself to a connection with Michael and what Rudolf Steiner called the Cosmic Intelligence, and at this time of year this theme gives us an opportunity to explore how the great art of Architecture has prepared us for something unimaginably greater. Andrew Wolpert's love of architecture connects with the Logos structure of Grammar, with what Blake called the Human Form Divine, and with the work of Michelangelo.

Transforming How we Face the World

Rudolf Steiner House was built between 1926 and 1937. It was designed by the architect Montague Wheeler (1874–1937, a member of the Board of Architectural Education from 1934–7. He was also an active member of the Anthroposophical Society.

The house was built as the 'home' of the Anthroposophical Society in London. As its name implies the building takes its inspiration from the work of Rudolf Steiner (1861–1925) and particularly from the first Goetheanum building at Dornach, Switzerland (1914), which was constructed of timber.

Steiner House is the first and only example of 'expressionist' architecture in London. The main staircase with its flowing forms and feeling of movement and metamorphosis, is a fine example of this style. The house was built in stages, starting with the theatre and the first-floor room behind it. Other rooms were added later as was the bookshop. The building was listed (Grade 2) in 1991.

In more recent times (2008/9), a new café area was constructed, whose wooden structure creates a polarity with the brick and concrete around it, and whose wooden beams echo the forms of the original Goetheanum.




